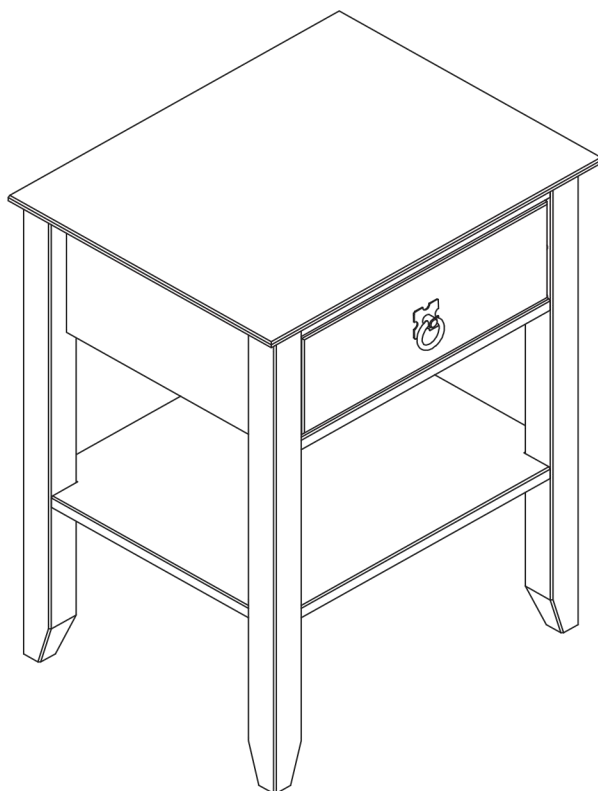

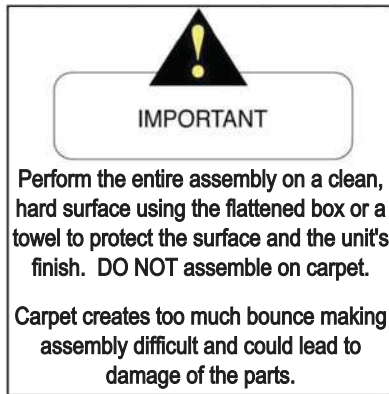
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### Parts of this product are real SOLID wood:

We inspect all wood and follow guidelines to pass quality inspections. Real solid wood has knots, small cracks, and what may look like blemishes. These characteristics are a natural by-product of producing furniture from natural material.

We take extra care with our drawer parts.

We use real wood drawer sides that are finely sanded to prevent snags to stored clothing. We do not paint the drawer sides to protect your clothing from chemical odors and residue.

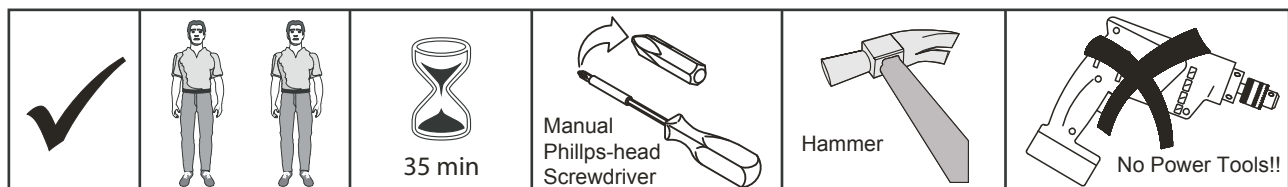

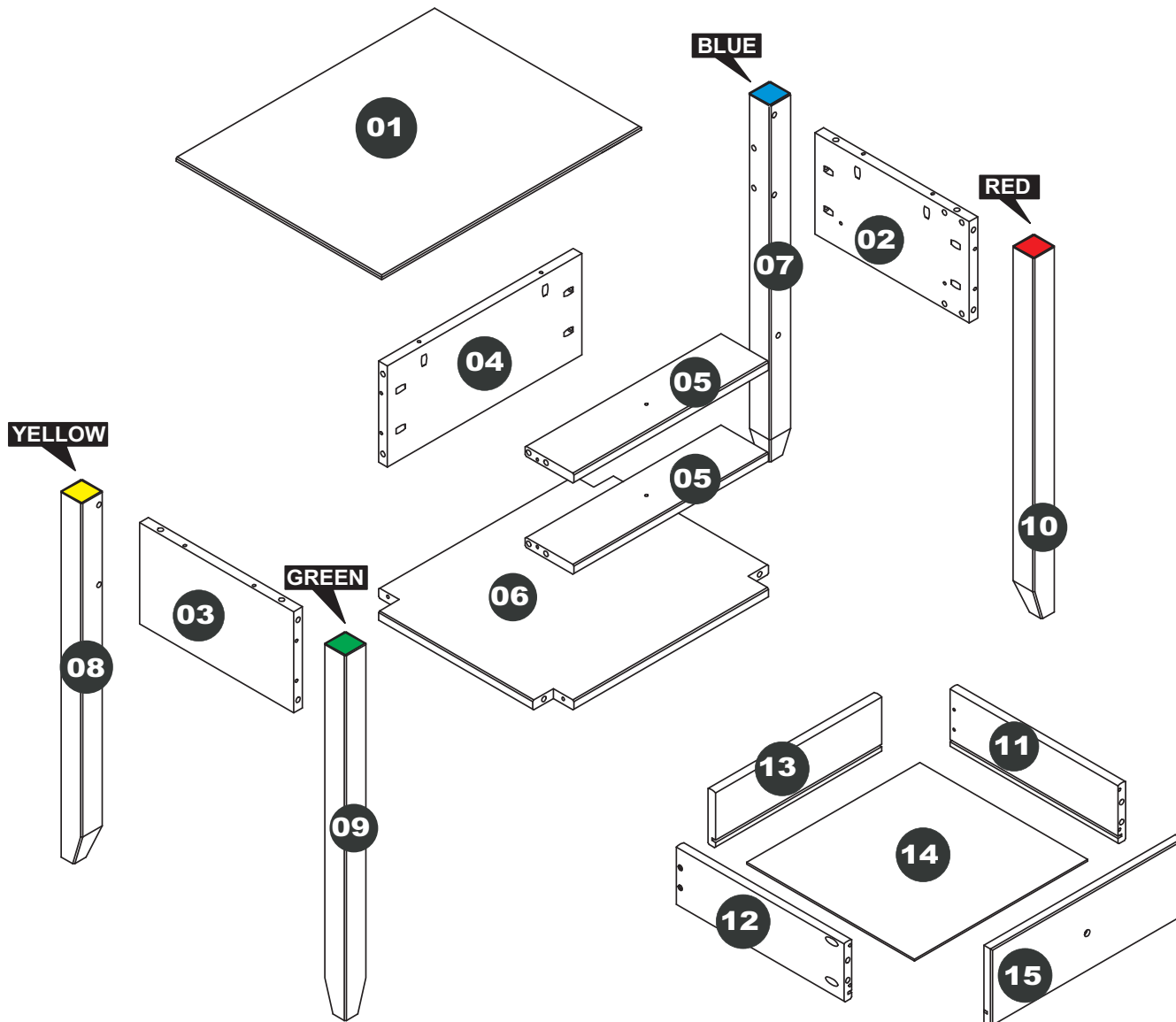

## Safety and Care Advice










- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 3 & 4.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Opened box can be used to protect your floor or counter during assembly.
- Assembly is easier for drawer parts on a counter.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit.
- Only use hand screwdrivers.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

## ASSEMBLE THE DRAWER BOX

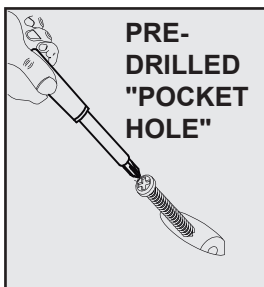


### Helpful Tip




To help assemble the drawer "square", use the drawer back #13 to stabilize the sides. Pull out after sides are attached, and slide in the drawer bottom.



**ATTACH THE KNOB TO THE DRAWER FRONT.**



**IMPORTANT! MAKE CERTAIN THE GROOVES FOR THE DRAWER BOTTOM IN THE DRAWER FRONT AND SIDES ALL ALIGN BEFORE TIGHTENING THE SCREWS.**

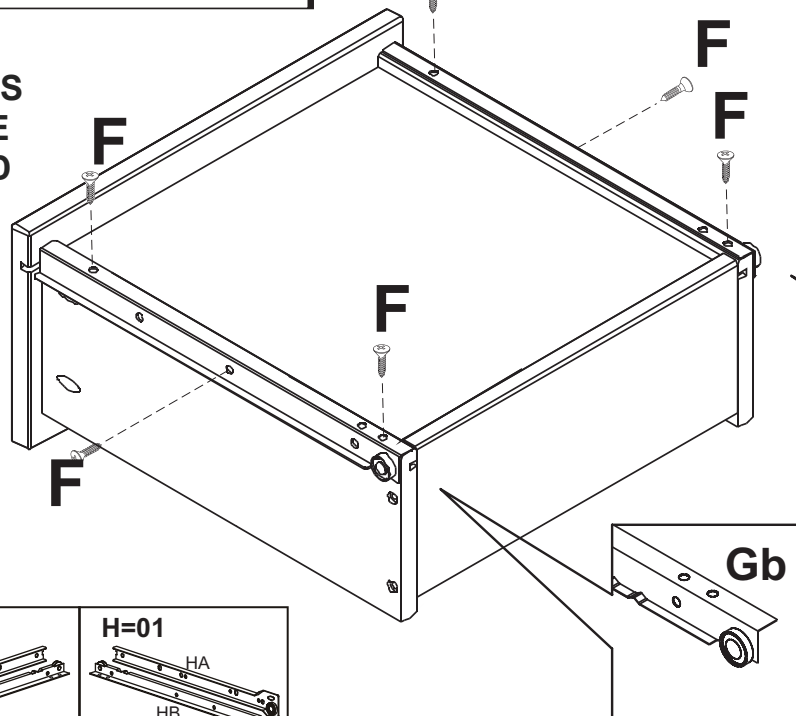
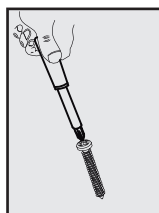

## ATTACH THE RIGHT AND LEFT DRAWER RUNNERS.



**TIP:** To make this step easier, place the drawer upside down on a counter with the drawer front hanging off the edge. This will allow the drawer box to lay flat and provide better control for tightening the screws. **DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN!**

**ENSURE THE WHEEL IS TOWARDS THE BACK AND THE RUNNER IS PUSHED COMPLETELY FORWARD, TOUCHING THE DRAWER FRONT.**



**ENSURE THE SCREWS ARE INSERTED THROUGH THE CORRECT HOLES IN THE RUNNER. SEE THE ENLARGED DIAGRAM ABOVE.**

## INSERT THE DRAWER

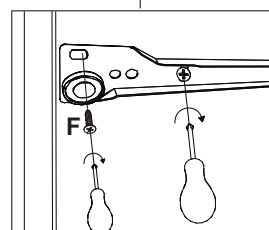
Tilt the back of the drawer upward to get it past the wheels on the drawer runners. Once clear of the wheels, you can level the drawer and slide it in.



**After completed assembly, it is necessary to adjust the drawer alignment to get the drawer perfectly square.**



- Loosen the screw (part F) you used to install the drawer runner to the side panel (parts 02 or 03), depending on the side (left or right), as shown.
- With the screw (part F) loosened, you can make the necessary slight adjustments (up or down) to the drawer runner to achieve the proper drawer front alignment.



**Once the drawer alignment is square, secure the position of the drawer runners to the side panels by re-tightening the part F screw.**

**CARE INSTRUCTIONS:**

- NORMAL USE: WIPE WITH A CLEAN CLOTH.
- OR WHEN NEEDED TO CLEAN SCUFFS: WIPE CLEAN WITH A SLIGHTLY DAMP CLOTH AND A MILD CLEANER. THEN WIPE DRY WITH A CLEAN CLOTH. DO NOT USE HARSH CHEMICALS.
- FROM TIME TO TIME, CHECK THAT ALL OF THE SCREWS ON THE UNIT ARE STILL TIGHT.
