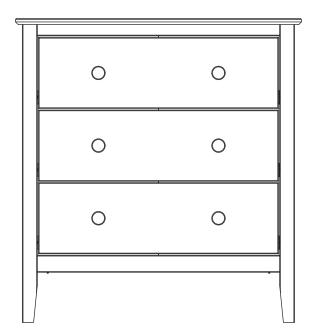

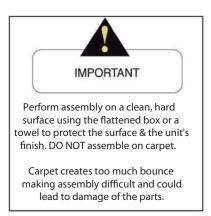
This is a **SOLID WOOD** product:

We inspect all wood and follow quality assurance guidelines that pass third-party inspections.

Note: Real wood has knots, small cracks, and what may look like blemishes. These characteristics are expected when producing furniture from natural material.

We take extra care with our drawer parts:

- 1. We use real wood drawer sides and drawer backs.
- 2. Drawer sides and backs are not finished to protect fabrics from any residual paint odor.
- 3. Drawer parts are finely sanded to prevent snags.





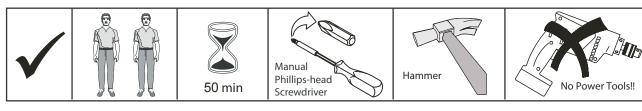
DO NOT FORCE OR **OVER-TIGHTEN THE** SCREWS. DOING SO CAN DAMAGE THE PARTS.

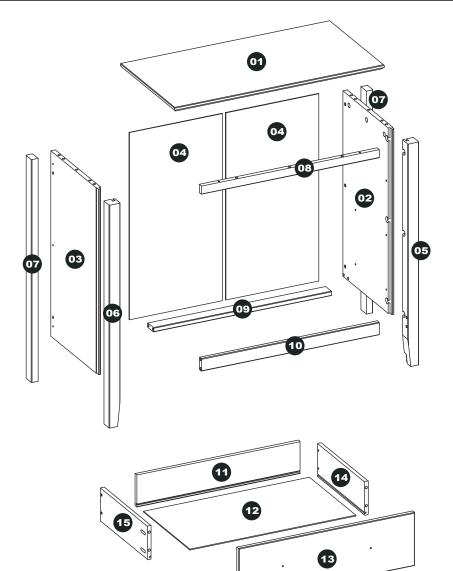


Safety and Care Advice

- · Check that you have all the components and tools listed on pages 3 & 4.
- · Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- · Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- · Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- · Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- · Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- · Opened box can be used to protect your floor or counter during assembly.
- · Assembly is easier for drawer parts on a counter.
- · Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- · We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws, as overtightening could damage the unit.
- Only use hand screwdrivers.
- · Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly. Please recycle the box. Go green
- · Never sit, stand or allow children to climb on the assembled unit.

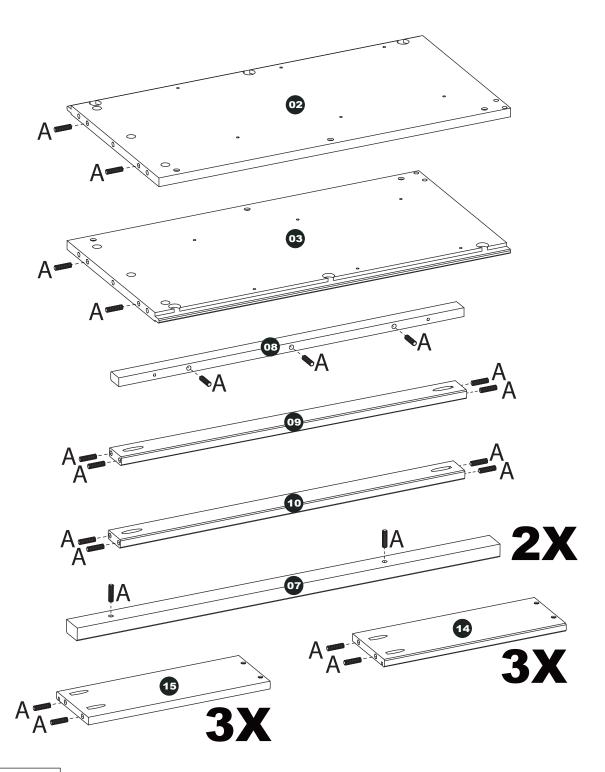


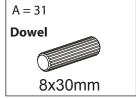

INSERT DOWELS INTO THE PARTS, AS SHOWN.

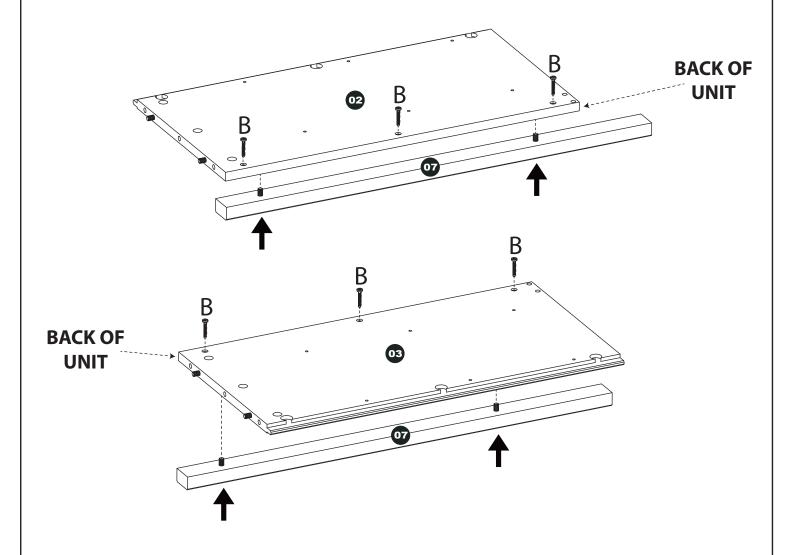


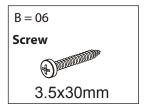


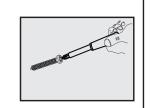


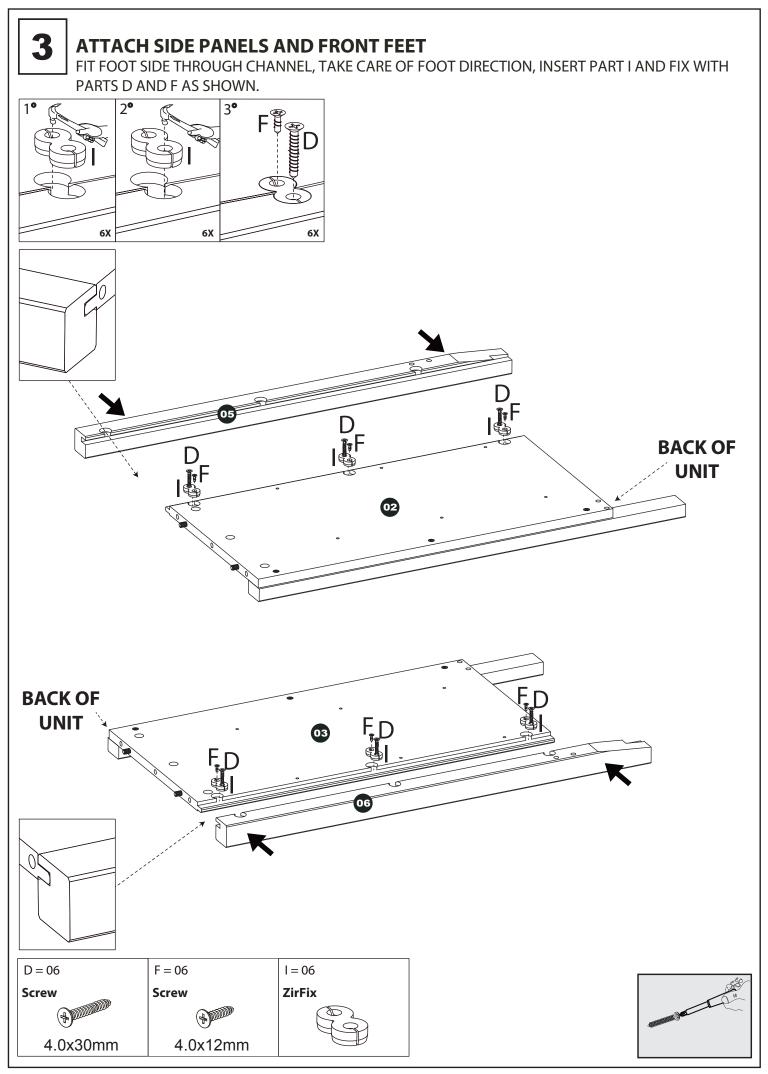
ATTACH SIDES PANELS AND BACK FEET

PLACE THE DOWELS FITTED IN THE HOLES ON THE SIDE, TAKE CARE OF THE FOOT DIRECTION AND FIX IT WITH PART B.





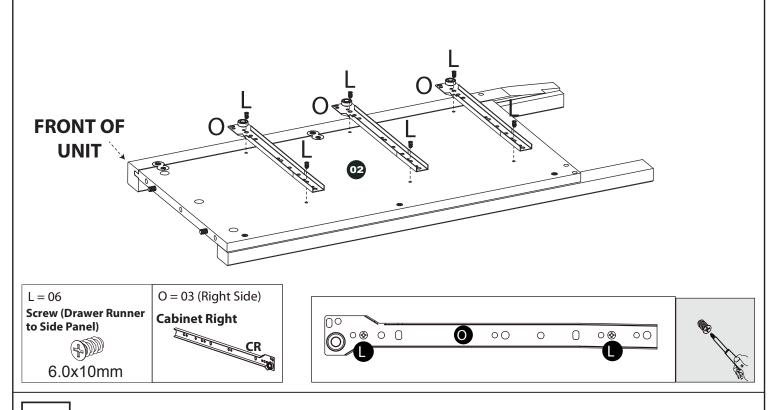






ATTACH DRAWER RUNNERS ON THE CABINET RIGHT SIDE PANEL

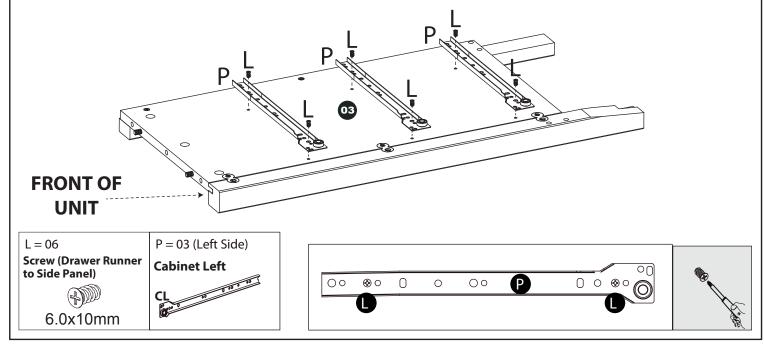
WITH THE WHEEL END OF THE RUNNER TOWARD THE FRONT (FINISHED) EDGE OF THE PANEL, ALIGN THE PRE-DRILLED HOLE ACOORDING TO THE DIAGRAM AND TIGHTEEN WITH PART L.





ATTACH DRAWER RUNNERS ON THE CABINET LEFT SIDE PANEL

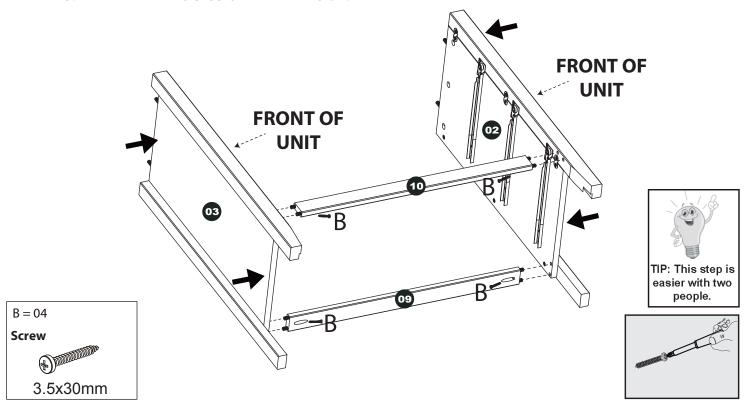
WITH THE WHEEL END OF THE RUNNER TOWARD THE FRONT (FINISHED) EDGE OF THE PANEL, ALIGN THE PRE-DRILLED HOLE ACOORDING TO THE DIAGRAM AND TIGHTEEN WITH PART L.

ATTACH CROSSBARS TO THE SIDE PANELS

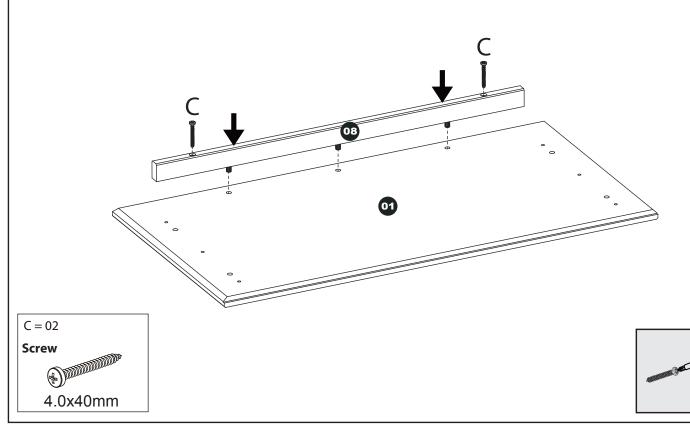
- 1. ALIGN THE DOWELS IN THE CROSSBARS WITH THE DOWEL HOLES IN THE RIGHT SIDE PANEL. THEN PUSH PARTS TOGETHER UNTIL FLUSH.
- 2. SECURE EACH CROSSBAR WITH ONE PART B.
- 3. REPEAT THE PROCESS ON THE LEFT SIDE.





ATTACH RAIL TO THE TOP PANEL

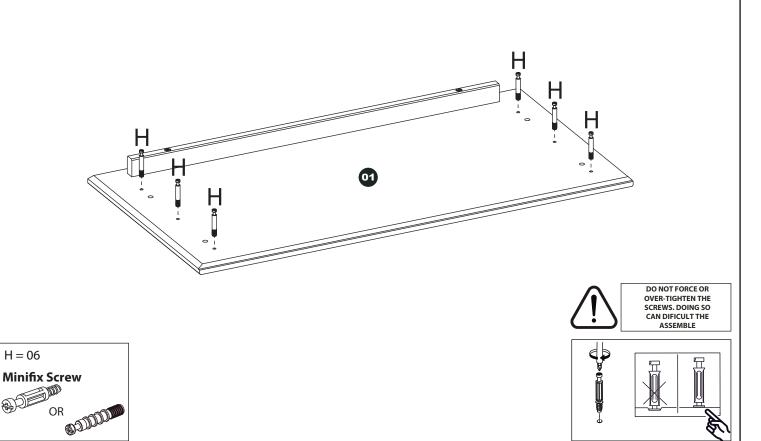
ATTACH FRONT CROSSBAR IN THE TOP PANEL USING THE PART C.





ATTACH MINIFIX TO THE TOP PANEL

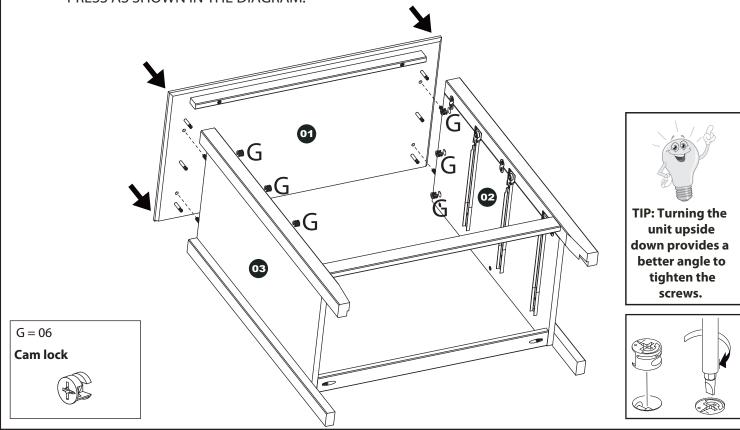
CAREFULLY CHECK THE HOLES INDICATED AND FIX PART H AS SHOWN.





ATTACH THE TOP PANEL WITH SIDE PANELS

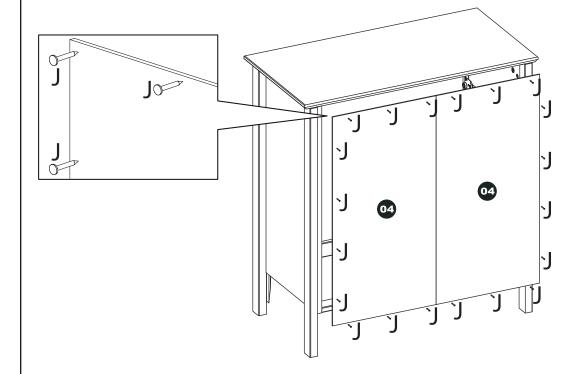
ALIGN THE DOWELS AND MINIFIX IN THE SIDE PANELS WITH THE PRE-DRILLED HOLES IN THE TOP PANEL, THEN THEY SHOW THE TOP OF MINIFIX IN THE HOLES ON THE SIDE, INSERT PART G AND PRESS AS SHOWN IN THE DIAGRAM.





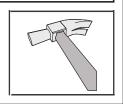
ATTACH THE BACK PANEL

- 1. UNFOLD THE BACK PANEL AND POSITION IT ON THE UNIT.
- 2. MAKE SURE THE BACK PANEL FITS INTO THE GROOVE ON THE BACK OF THE TOP PANEL.
- 3. SECURE THE BACK PANEL WITH THE BACK PANEL NAILS OBSERVING THE SQUARE.





Use all back panels nails. Evenly spaced, they help make the unit strong.





SECURE THE UNIT TO THE WALL WITH THE ANTI-TIP KIT

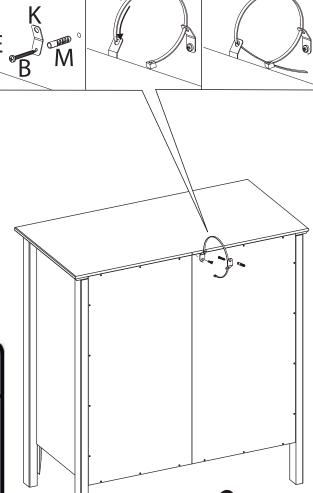
1. INSERT THE ANCHOR INTO THE WALL APPROXIMATELY 803MM (31,6IN) FROM THE FLOOR (ADJUST FOR CARPET OR RUG THICKNESS IF APLICABLE).

2. FEED PART B THROUGH THE SMALLER HOLE IN THE BRACKET AND SECURE INTO THE WALL ANCHOR. THE OTHER END OF THE BRACKET SHOULD BE UPWARD.

3. FEED PART E THROUGH THE SMALLER HOLE IN THE OTHER BRACKET AND SECURE THROUGH THE BACK PANEL AND INTO THE CENTER OF THE TOP PANEL. THE OTHER END OF THE BRACKET SHOULD BE UPWARD. 4. FEED THE STRAP THROUGH THE LARGER HOLE IN THE WALL BRACKET FROM UNDERNEATH. BRING THE STRAP OVER TO THE UNIT BRACKET AND THROUGH THE HOLE FROM ABOVE.

5. INSERT THE POINTED END OF THE STRAP INTO THE CLASP END OF THE STRAP AND TIGHTEN DOWN.

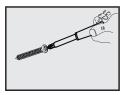

WALL

WARNING

SERIOUS OR FATAL CRUSHING INJURIES CAN OCCUR FROM FURNITURE TIP-OVER. TO AVOID TIP-OVER:

- PLACE HEAVIEST ITEMS IN THE LOWEST DRAWERS.
- UNLESS SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED TO ACCOMODATE, DO NOT SET TV'S OR OTHER HEAVY OBJECTS ON TOP OF THIS PRODUCT.
- NEVER ALLOW CHILDREN TO CLIMB OR HANG ON DOORS, DRAWERS OR SHELVES.
- NEVER OPEN MORE THAN ONE DRAWER AT A TIME.
- KEEP REMOTE CONTROLS, TOYS AND OTHER ITEMS THAT MAY ATTRACT CHILDREN OFF OF THIS PRODUCT.

USE OF TIP-OVER RESTRAINTS MAY ONLY REDUCE. BUT NOT ELIMINATE, THE RISK OF TIP-OVER.

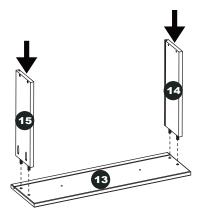

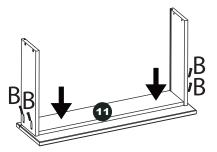


ASSEMBLE 3X DRAWER BOX

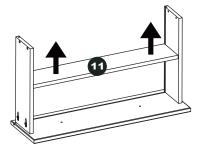
IMPORTANT: MAKE SURE THE GROOVES IN THE DRAWER FRONT AND BOTH SIDES ALL ALIGN BEFORE TIGHTEENING THE SCREWS.



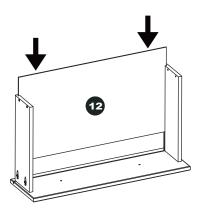
1. ALIGN THE DOWELS IN THE DRAWER SIDES WITH THE PRE-DRILLED HOLES IN THE DRAWER FRONT AND PUSH UNTIL THE PARTS ARE FLUSH.



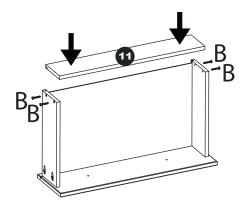
2. USE THE DRAWER BACK TO SUPPORT THE DRAWER SIDES. THEN SECURE THEM TO THE DRAWER FRONT.



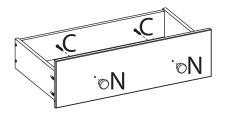
3. REMOVE THE DRAWER BACK.



4. SLIDE IN THE DRAWER BOTTOM. MAKE SURE IT IS ALL THE WAY FORWARD & IN THE GROOVE ON THE DRAWER FRONT.

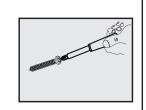


5. MAKE SURE THE DRAWER **BOTTOM IS IN THE GROOVE** IN THE DRAWER BACK AND THE DRAWER BACK IS FLUSH WITH THE DRAWER SIDES. SECURE WITH 2 PART C ON EACH SIDE.



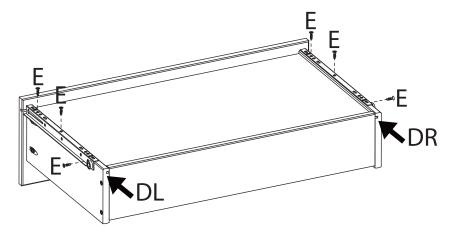
6. ATTACH THE KNOBS TO THE DRAWER FRONT.





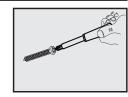
ATTACH 3X DRAWER RUNNERS

- 1. POSITION THE RIGHT DRAWER RUNNER "DR" WITH THE WHEEL TOWARD THE BACK OF THE DRAWER AND THE FRONT END ALL THE WAY FORWARD TOUCHING THE DRAWER FRONT.
- 2. FIRST SCREW GOES IN THE THIRD HOLE BACK FROM THE DRAWER FRONT.
- 3. SECOND SCREW GOES IN THE FIFTH BACK HOLE FROM THE DRAWER FRONT.
- 4. THIRD SCREW GOES IN FROM THE SIDE THROUGH THE FIRST HOLE IN FRONT OF THE WHELL.
- 5. REPEAT THE PROCESS ON THE LEFT SIDE AND FOR EACH DRAWER.





TIP: To make this step easier, place the drawer upside down on a counter with the drawer front hanging off the edge. This will allow the drawer box to lay flat and provide better control for tightening the screws

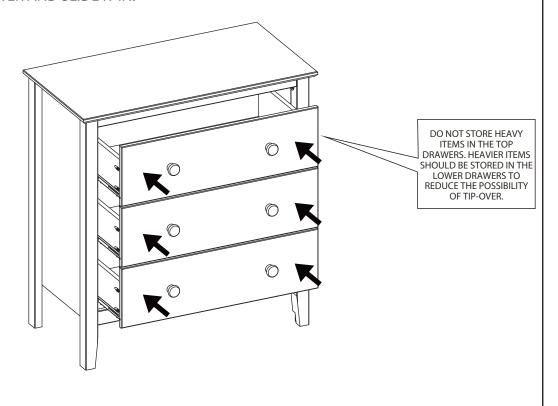


P = 03 (Left Side) **Drawer Left Runner**



INSERT THE DRAWERS IN THE UNIT

- 1. START AT THE BOTTOM AND WORK UP.
- 2. HOLDING THE FRONT END OF THE DRAWER SIDES, TILT THE BACK OF THE DRAWER UPWARDS TO GET THE WHEELS ON THE DRAWER PAST THE WHEELS ON THE UNIT. ONCE THE WHEELS ARE CLEAR, LEVEL OUT THE DRAWER AND SLIDE IT IN.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

NORMAL USE: WIPE WITH A CLEAN CLOTH. WHEN NEEDED TO CLEAN SCUFFS: WIPE CLEAN WITH A SLIGHTLY DAMP CLOTH AND A MILD CLEANSER. THEN WIPE DRY WITH A CLEAN CLOTH. DO NOT USE HARSH CHEMICALS. OCCASIONALLY CHECK THAT THE SCREWS IN THE UNIT REMAIN TIGHT.
